Lane Closure Report for the Week of 6/8/2020 – 6/12/2020

Inyo, Mono & Eastern Kern Counties — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) would like to alert the traveling public to be careful of workers on the highway, to Be Work Zone Alert and Move Over where possible.

The scheduled lane closures for the week of June 6 through June 12 are:

Mono County:

- **Aspen/Walker Shoulder Project** – On U.S. Highway 395, from Devils Gate Summit (PM 88.0) to the junction of State Route 108 (PM 93.7) construction crews are widening the highway. Traffic may encounter up to 20-minute delays as vehicles are piloted through the active work zone, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- **Mono 108 Truck Turn Around Project** - On State Route 108, 1.7 miles from the junction of U.S. Highway 395 (PM 13.4). Crews are creating a safe turnaround for restricted trucks. Traffic should not be affected during this construction project.
- **Mono Sign Project** - On U.S. Highway 395, from Topaz Inspection Station (PM 120.1) to the junction of SR 108 (PM 93.7), crews are replacing highway signs. Traffic will encounter lane closures with no anticipated delays, Monday through Friday, from 6:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Inyo County:

- **Olancha Thin Blanket Project** – On U.S. Highway 395, from the intersection of SR 190 (PM 31.2) to the Los Angeles Aqueduct Bridge (PM 34.7) construction crews are placing a thin blanket of asphalt concrete. Traffic may encounter up to 20-minute delays as vehicles are piloted through the active work zone one direction at a time, Monday through Thursday, from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm and on Friday, from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm. Due to higher than normal traffic volumes, delay's may be longer than 20 minutes.
- **Highway Maintenance** - On State Route 168, from Reata Road (PM 15.68) to Meadow Lane (PM 16.062), crews are working on the utilities. Traffic will encounter lane closures with no anticipated delays on Thursday, from 12:30 pm to 5:00 pm.

Kern County:

- **Inyokern Shoulder Widening Project** - On State Route 178, in Inyokern from Redrock Inyokern Road to the intersection of U.S. Highway 395 northbound on- and off-ramps, crews are widening the highway. Traffic may encounter up to 20-minute delays as vehicles are piloted through the active work zone, Sunday night through Friday, from 8:00 pm to 7:00 am.
- **Cache Creek Bridge Replacement Project** - On State Route 58, 5 miles east of Tehachapi, crews are replacing two, two-lane bridges that cross over Cache Creek. There will be lane closures with a slight detour and minimal delay, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- **Miscellaneous Utility Work** - On State Route 202, from Bear Valley Road (PM R1.63) to Cummings Valley Road (PM R2.16), crews are working on the utilities. Traffic will encounter lane closures with no anticipated delays on Friday, from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm.

Work schedules are subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and/or construction-related issues.
