HIGH (Confidence	•

- Heat is the #1 cause of weather-related fatalities in Las Vegas and the United States.
- Prolonged exposure to heat can result in heat exhaustion and heat stroke.
- Increased risk to children and pets left in vehicles or outdoors.

MODERATE Confidence

• Higher temperatures may increase heat-related emergency calls.

Details:

Forecast high temperatures Friday through Labor Day:

- Las Vegas, Pahrump, Barstow, Morongo Basin: 108 to 112
- Lake Havasu City, Needles, Bullhead City, Overton, and other Colorado River communities: 112 to 117
- Bishop, Rachel, Beatty, Kingman: 102 to 106
- Furnace Creek (Death Valley National Park): around 123

Heat Returning for the Holiday Weekend


Expectations

- Hottest days Friday through Labor Day (and perhaps beyond?), with temperatures about 10 degrees above normal and flirting with records for early September.
- Widespread High to Extreme heat risk expected over the Labor Day weekend.


HEAT RISK LEVELS


Category	Level	Meaning	
Green	0	No Elevated Risk	
Yellow	1	Low Risk for those extremely sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration	
Orange	2	Moderate Risk for those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration	
Red	3	High Risk for much of the population, especially those who are heat sensitive and those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration	
Magenta 4		Very High Risk for entire population due to long duration heat, with little to no relief overnight	

Excessive Heat Watch | Friday through Labor Day





High Temperatures & Heat Risk - Friday







High Temperatures & Heat Risk - Saturday
